CIVIL AIR PATROL UNIFORM MANUAL

CAPM 39-1, dated 26 June 2014 is supplemented as follows:

1. In accordance with CAPM 39-1 paragraph 9-3 the following shoulder cords are authorized for wear by Northeast Region Cadets:
 - a. A blue and white interwoven shoulder cord (Vanguard item #3740400) is authorized to be worn by cadets that have graduated or served as staff of a Northeast Region Cadet Leadership School (RCLS) starting with the summer 2011 NER RCLS. The shoulder cord will be worn in accordance with the requirements of CAPM 39-1. This shoulder cord is NOT authorized for wear by senior members.
2. Only one shoulder cord may be worn at any time. Shoulder cords specifically authorized by CAP regulation (CAC cords, Honor Guard cord, etc.) will take precedence over these cords. These shoulder cords will be purchased at the member's expense.
3. In accordance with CAPM 39-1, Attachment 4 – Table of Badges, Devices and Patches, the following patches are authorized for wear by Northeast Region members:
 - a. The "Northeast Region Cadet Leadership School Patch" (Attachment 1) is authorized to be worn by cadets and senior members who have graduated from Northeast Region Cadet Leadership School starting with the summer of 2011. The patch will be worn centered on the left breast pocket of the BDU uniform. One patch will be issued at the conclusion of the activity. Members may purchase additional patches at their own expense from Vanguard.

b. The "Staff" patch (Attachment 1) is authorized to be worn by cadets and senior members who have successfully completed a term of service as a member of the RCLS starting the summer of 2011. The patch will be worn on top of and resting on the basic RCLS patch. This combined patch will be worn centered on the lower portion of the left breast pocket of the BDU. One patch will be issued at the conclusion of the activity. Members may purchase additional patches at their own expense from Vanguard.
